Questions

1. What was the circumstance in Israel when God tells Elijah to go to Ahab?
2. Why did Obadiah fear being killed if he told Ahab that Elijah was coming to see him?
3. How did Ahab greet Elijah and what was Elijah's response?
- Isn't it often the case that the person who is trying to tell the truth is called a "troubling"? What is it about the truth that creates such anger in people?
4. How many false prophets did Elijah meet at Mt. Carmel? Who were "Baal" and "Asherah"? What was Elijah's challenge to the people?
5. Describe the nature of the confrontation. What was Elijah trying to prove? Did he succeed?
6. What happened to the false prophets after the confrontation? What happened to Elijah? Where did he go?
7. What was Jezebel's pledge? What was Elijah's response to this threat?
8. Describe the interaction between God and Elijah. What lessons can we take home with us?
